The Role

The Children's Worker position is part time, 15 hours a week. This is a 12 month appointment, which will then be reviewed in the light of funding. Salary is £7,800 pa (£10/hour), annual leave is four weeks.

The job will include working weekends.

1. To run the Sunday Club (during the 11am service)
2. To run school holiday activities and one-off children's events
3. To build on links and work with Avonmore Primary School.
4. Look to develop mid-week children's activity at St Mary's
5. To help out with other Church activities as appropriate
